

## Camp Bible Class Teachers, Consider This....

Your teaching can never accomplish the real aims for which it is intended unless it challenges each camper to think earnestly, examine self, and strive for a higher plain of spiritual living. Remember that you are not merely teaching the Bible, but molding lives and preparing souls for heaven. You are molding and preparing, not merely relating doctrine. Therefore, you must realize that you must proceed with patience, earnestness, love, and a personal interest in each camper that you teach. You must help each camper to see that Christianity is a LIFESTYLE, not merely a dogma to be accepted. You must, therefore, direct your teaching to the hearts of the camper. They must be made to feel that the lesson is for them and see that it has value for them.

When campers fail to prepare for their lessons, or are tardy, or absent without approval of the Camp Nurse or Camp Director, you should investigate and find out why. You have a significant role in the overall camp program and a real opportunity to make a difference in the campers life.

A few pointers:

- Know your subject
- Be enthusiastic
- Be sincere
- Be calm
- Be relaxed
- Don't pretend to know all the answers
- Get involved with other areas of the camping program
