A Christian Camp Board of Directors should be composed of dedicated Christian people actively involved in the operation of the camp. Here are 10 suggested responsibilities of Board Members.

1. Chosen by the Corporation, Board Members conduct camp business for the Corporation.
2. The purpose of the Board is to guide the Corporation and the camp in the proper direction by encouraging programs that provide physical, spiritual, mental, and social growth.
3. They are to make decisions based on the goal of ensuring the smooth operation of the camp.
4. Each Board Member should be actively serving on a committee.
5. Board members should select experienced and competent Camp Directors.
6. Board members should be flexible to meet the special needs and possible changes in the camping program.
7. Board Members, when possible, should be involved in some in-camp function, such as Directing, teaching, counseling, etc.
8. Board Members should see that facilities are properly maintained and expanded when needed.
9. Board Members should take seriously the financial needs of the camp by personally helping with fund raising efforts.
10. Board Members should consider themselves ambassadors of the camp by promoting camp at every opportunity.
